
Domain Registration

- * Top Level Domain (TLDs)
 - * .com, co.uk, .je, .me, .org or .photography etc.
- * Consider Name
 - * Pen Island www.penisland.net
 - * Think longer term
- * Register more than one?
 - * <u>www.jerseyphotoclub.org</u> Free domain included hosting (first year only)

Website Hosting and CMS – Open versus Closed

- * Example 1 Word Press Open Source Platform
 - * Tools: Access to thousands tools
 - * Support: Not supported but online information
 - * Hosting: Choose where to host and can move
- * Example 2 Squarespace Closed Platform
 - * Tools: Limited tools compared with Word Press
 - * Support: 24x7 Customer Support & Online videos
 - * Hosting: Locked In

Website Hosting

- * Check your Hosting/CMS works with your home device
 - * Seen some not work with Mac's!
 - * Check browser: Squarespace does not like IE9!
 - * Majority have free trial period
- Unlimited or Restricted Storage / Bandwidth
 - * Read the small print!
- * Consider Email Hosting with Domain
- * Auto Renewal (don't let it lapse)

Website Hosting Cost Example



Domain Registration www.1and1.co.uk

- * .com £10.99 includes: 1 e-mail account and unlimited forwarding
 - * <u>Stephen@grouville.com</u> (email account); <u>lumiere@grouville.com</u>; <u>fatherchristmas@grouville.com</u> (can forward to any email address)
- * Hosting <u>www.squarespace.com</u> Professional Option
 - * \$192 annual or \$16 a month
 - * Unlimited pages, galleries, and blogs, with unlimited storage and no caps on bandwidth

Website Design

- * Create Logo May need two versions
- * Create Site Map
 - * Card Sort Exercise
- * Header & Footer
- * Accessibility
- Links open new page
- * Naming convention Pages/Files
- Page Not Found 404 Error


Types May Require 2 Versions

Website Design Title & Tag Line



SITE TITLE / TAG LINE

The Site Title is used wherever the title of the site appears, while the Tag Line is used on some templates where applicable.

Upload a logo image to be used in the place of your site title. Use the template style editor to control your logo size on screen directly from the front of your site.








Template & Layouts Image Stored?




