Entering PDIs for Competitions

- a) You can enter up to 3 PDIs (Projected Digital Images) for most club competitions.
- b) You should upload them to the club's PhotoEntry site (<https://compent.photoentry.uk/compent/>) by midnight on the closing date for entries which is normally the Monday before the competition.
- c) You should make sure that:
 - no watermark is visible on the photograph
 - you enter a title for each image that doesn't include your name
 - you select the criteria for publishing top images.
- d) Images should be uploaded as JPEG (or JPG) files which have an sRGB colour profile.
 - you can upload image files up to 10MB in size – the PhotoEntry system will automatically re-size them: for internal competitions images will be re-sized to a maximum of 1600 pixels (px) wide and 1200 px high for projection.
 - if your original image file is bigger than 10MB then you will need to re-size the image yourself before you upload it.
 - if you have Lightroom it's easy to specify an image size – just set up an export preset with 1600 px as the maximum size for the width and 1200 px as the maximum size for the height.
